Open the Pear Deck Sidebar within your slide presentation. For Google Slides, go to Add-ons in the navigation bar, select Pear Deck for Google Slides Add-on, and click Open Pear Deck Add-on. For Microsoft PowerPoint Online, click Home in the navigation bar, click the three dots on the right to see more options, and select Pear Deck.

Using the Pear Deck Sidebar, add interactivity to your slides! Choose one of our Text, Number Response, Multiple Choice, Web Slide, Drawing*, or Draggable[™]* question types to add a formative assessment to the current slide.
