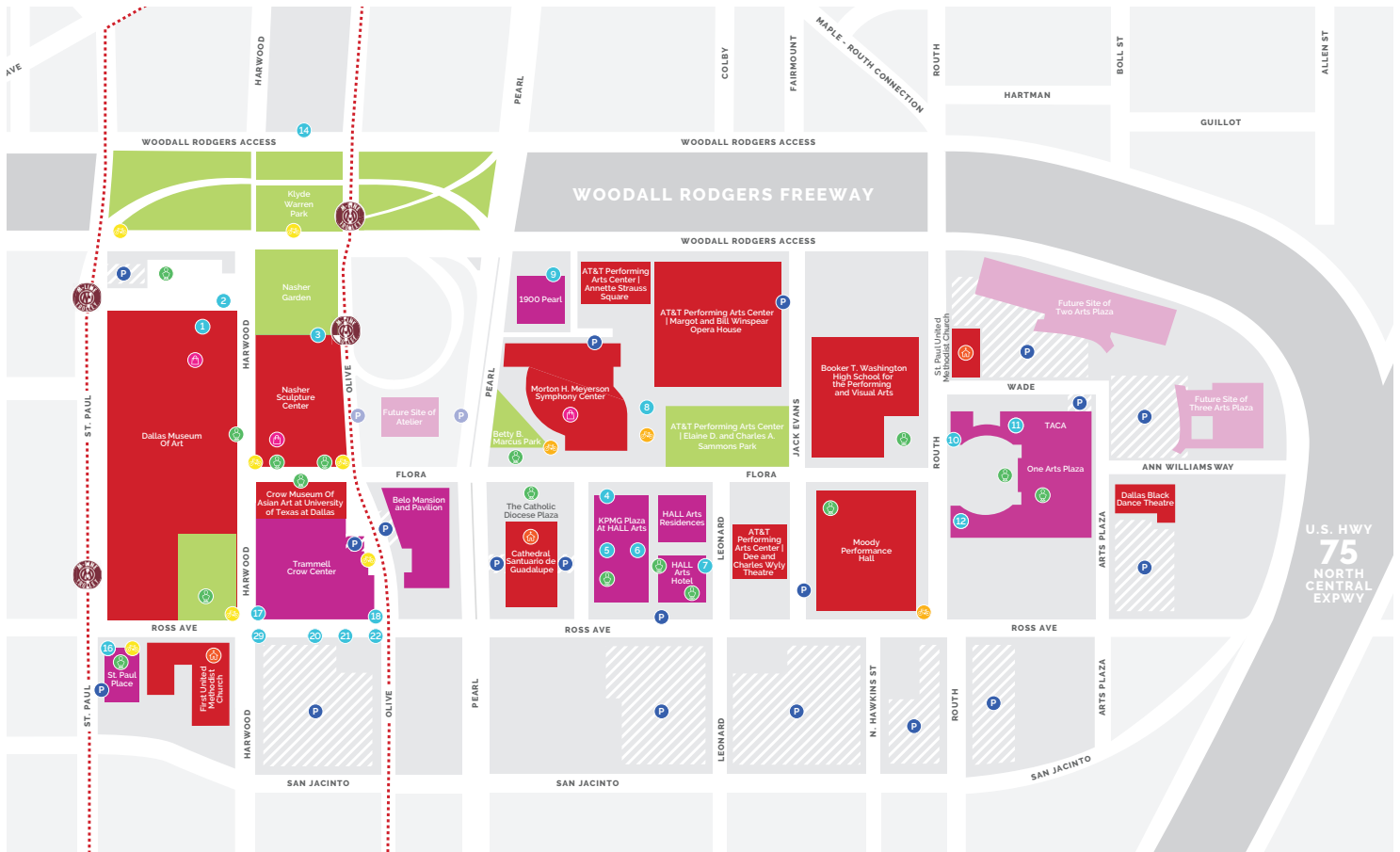
please utilize these special parking areas for your coaches.

CULTURAL ACTIVITIES

Spread over 20 square blocks and encompassing 68 acres, the **Dallas Arts District** is a walkable downtown hub of creativity, featuring art for all the senses with award-winning museums and performing arts venues. The district is home to cultural institutions like the **Dallas Museum of Art**, the **Crow Museum of Asian Art** (both free general admission), the **Nasher Sculpture Center**, **Morton H. Meyerson Symphony Center** and **AT&T Performing Arts Center**. A few blocks away, history buffs will want to visit the **Dallas Holocaust and Human Rights Museum**.

EDUCATIONAL

Start with a fun educational experience at one of Dallas' most unique museums. At the **Perot Museum of Nature and Science** and the **George W. General admission is free to both the DMA and Crow. The museums are just steps away from **Klyde Warren Park**, an engaging park in the middle of the Arts District that's always buzzing with activity such as games, yoga, lunch-time performances and food trucks.

OFF THE BEATEN PATH
