



HOTELS ON THE HORIZON

From the intimacy of boutique hotels to the convenience and luxury of large convention hotels, all the nation's top brands are represented in Dallas. The city's 34,000 hotel rooms - 15,000 in the walkable downtown core - provide accommodations for any preference and price point. With 173 projects and 20,707 hotel rooms in the pipeline, Dallas leads the nation in the number of rooms under construction.

■ JW MARRIOTT // 2023

Dallas' first JW Marriott Hotel is scheduled to open in spring 2023. The 23-story luxury property is located in the heart of the city's Arts District and features 267 guest rooms, ground-level entry, three restaurants, a sky lobby, fitness center, two ballrooms, meeting and conference areas, cocktail lounge, a pool deck, and more.

■ HARWOOD HOTEL // 2023

A new 20-story luxury hotel in under construction in Uptown's Harwood District. The Harwood Boutique Hotel will be minutes away from Downtown, the American Airlines Center, the Dallas Arts District and great bar and dining options. While major details are being kept under wraps, architectural renderings show a sculptural white building with cantilevered upper floors and a swimming pool and garden on the roof.

■ PLÜSH SUITES // 2023

Plush Suites will be a 12-story, 300-key hotel near the Galleria shopping mall in North Dallas. The project will offer affordable, upscale rooms just steps away from the Galleria Mall and countless dining and entertainment options. The rooms will offer generous space with the smallest room measuring 500 square feet, while three-bedroom suites will be as large as 1,300 square feet.

■ FOUR SEASONS // 2025

Four Seasons is slated to bring a 240-room resort-style hotel to Dallas's Turtle Creek neighborhood, situated between Uptown and Highland Park. Plans for the \$750 million high-rise include an eye-popping circular glass entry court and rooftop pool and garden space.

■ INTERCONTINENTAL DALLAS // 2025

InterContinental Hotels & Resorts will return to Dallas at Cityplace Tower, in Uptown, featuring iconic design and sweeping panoramic views of the Dallas skyline. Guests will enjoy spacious, high-end rooms and amenities, including a rooftop infinity pool and lounge and over 21,000 square feet of event space.
